

Ten things you can do to get out the count.

1. Text or call 10 friends or family members to make sure they've completed the census!
2. Post about the census on social media!

3. Hang up census posters in your building, elevator, or in your window!

4. If you use a work email address, put a census message in your email signature that links to my2020census.gov
5. Have a special language skill? Record a video in another language!
6. Reach out to your building or housing association about sending an email to their tenants about the importance of the census. ➡ [EXAMPLE](#)
7. Write an op-ed or letter to the editor about the importance of the census.

8. Engage your network! Think through who is in your network and how they can motivate others to complete the census.
 - a. Are you involved in a faith group (mosque, church, synagogue, etc.)? Can they speak about the census?
 - b. Do any of your schools have alumni associations? Can they share a video about the census?
 - c. Do you belong to any other civic engagement groups or volunteer groups? Can you speak at an upcoming meeting or ask them to share an email?
9. Do you receive a newsletter or are you on an email listserv? Email them a census message and ask that they blast out to the network.
10. Have a tie to a business? Ask if they can hang up a poster near the check out stand!
